GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

All references should be provided in English in the style of the APA. To determine the format to use for a reference list entry, first determine the reference group (e.g., textual works, online media) and reference category (e.g., periodical, social media), and then choose the appropriate reference type on [APA website](#) and follow that example. Also, you can find an APA structure for common reference examples in table below.

After creating your reference list, we also ask you to check that:

- references style is alphabetical;
- a DOI is included (if available);
- URL works correctly;

Please ignore APA's hanging indentation in reference list.

Journal Article	Surname, initials (Year). Title of article. <i>Journal name</i> , volume (issue), page range. DOI
Online Magazine Article	Surname, initials (Year, Month Date). [Title of article]. <i>Magazine name</i> . DOI or URL
Print Magazine Article	Surname, initials (Year, Month). [Title of article]. <i>Magazine name</i> . volume (issue), page range
Online Newspaper Article	Surname, initials (Year, Month Date). [Title of article]. <i>Newspaper name</i> . DOI or URL
Print Newspaper Article	Surname, initials (Year, Month). [Title of article]. <i>Magazine name</i> . volume (issue), page range
Book	Surname, initials (Copyright year). <i>Title of a book</i> . Publisher. DOI or URL
Chapter in Edited Book	Surname, initials (Copyright year). Title of a book chapter. In Initials Surname (Eds), <i>Title of a book</i> (edition or volume, page numbers). Publisher. DOI or URL
Organization report	Group or Organization name. (Year). <i>Title of report</i> . URL
Report by individual author at organization	Surname, initials (Year). <i>Title of report</i> . Organization Name. URL
Dissertation From a Database	Surname, initials (Year). <i>Title of dissertation</i> (Publication No.) [Doctoral dissertation or master's thesis, Institution name]. Database Name.
Data Set	Surname, initials or Name of Group (Year). <i>Title of dataset</i> (Version No.) [Data set]. Publisher name. DOI or URL
Transliteration News website, no author	<i>Title of the news in original language</i> [English transliteration]. (Year, Month Date). Website name. URL

¹ Please use direct links to the examples, provided by APA on their website.

² For multiple articles by the same author, or authors listed in the same order, list the entries in chronological order, from earliest to most recent.

³ If a source has two or more authors, separate author names with a comma. Use the "&" instead of "and.". If a source has three to twenty, only the last author name is preceded by ampersand ("&").
